The transfer packages includes a DVM exam, hourly nursing care, administration of provided IV fluids, injections or prescriptions,

and additional analgesic treatment if necessary including injectables and or CRIs.

We welcome the opportunity to treat any and all patients overnight, and will discuss any alternative care options with you prior to transfer.

Our ambition is to provide care and monitoring over-

night and either transfer patients back to your hospital in the morning or send patients home with your individualized discharge instructions.

Minimally Invasive Flank Gastropexy

Willamette Veterinary Hospital is excited to provide a Minimal Invasive Paracostal (Flank) Gastropexy + Neuter Package . The package includes the surgery (neuter+pexy), pre-anesthetic lab work, and all necessary medications (including go-home medications).

Gastropexy + neuter

This procedure utilizes anatomic landmarks (right flank) to facilitate a direct approach, making a minimal invasive incision of about 5cm. This procedure is ideal to perform in combination with neuter based on surgical sites and size of incisions required. Alternatively, this is a great standalone option for already altered males or females (stand-alone package \$750).

Benefits

The flank gastropexy benefits stem primarily from the location and size of surgery. The smaller incision size yields for decreased geographic inflammation and subsequent pain. The size also allows for decreased time under anesthesia. In addition to the traditional gastropexy prophylactic benefits, the Flank gastropexy provides a beneficial option for our at risk patients while decreasing the time and exposure into the abdomen.
